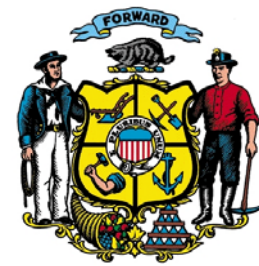




## Thursday, July 14, 2005 Door County, WI “Capital for the Day”
