
Agreement on the Establishment of Friendly Cooperative Relations between Jingdezhen Municipality of People's Republic of China and Door County of United States of America

Based upon the principles of the Joint Communiqué on the Establishment of China and the United States of America, for the purpose of promoting friendly cooperation and exchange, enhancing the relationship between the people of the two regions, so as to promote mutual development, Jingdezhen Municipal People's Government and Door County Government reach consensus in the following aspects:

- I. Both parties cooperate to establish and strengthen their relationship to facilitate the opportunity of middle and primary students to travel and train in the ceramic arts, use existing educational institutions such as the Ceramic Arts Center of China and institutions of art instruction in Door County as the platform to facilitate the exchange of students and teachers.
- II. Actively promote both party's non-governmental multi-channels, multi-levels and omni-directional cooperation and exchange of science and technology, promote the understanding, cooperation and exchange among scientific and technological enterprise and gardens, universities, foundations and investment companies, and so on; establish scientific and technologic cooperation union committee, to facilitate a regular dialogue schedule between the parties, to discuss the scientific and technologic cooperation items which both parties propose, and facilitate the exchange of lectures and research.


- III. Both parties will follow the principle of WTO and protect intellectual property rights. Promote technologic exchange and cooperation; promote trade and actively set up the platform, create opportunity and chance, promote investment and cooperation to enhance the cultural and economic development of the two regions.
- IV. Both parties will regularly try to send touring parties and media to gather information and ideas; the two parties will work to facilitate this travel in order to deepen the friendship of the people of two regions.
- V. Develop the exchange of culture of the two regions, facilitate the display of Jingdezhen art from different dynasties to display in U.S.A., facilitate the performance and exchange of local theatrical art performances, such as, an evening party of porcelain capital spirit (porcelain song, porcelain music and porcelain dance), as well events focusing on similar arts culture in Door County.
- VI. The mentioned above paper has two original copies. Each side keeps one copy. The Chinese version and the English version are equally valid.



Agreement Between Jingdezhen City of Jiangxi Province of the People's Republic of China and Door County, State of Wisconsin, United States of America, on the Establishment of Friendship City Relationship


Jingdezhen City of Jiangxi Province of the People's Republic of China and Door County, State of Wisconsin, the United States of America, acting in accordance with the principles of the Joint Communiqué on the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations between the People's Republic of China and the United States of America, wishing to enhance mutual understanding and friendship between the Chinese and American peoples, and consolidate and develop friendly cooperation between the two cities, have reached agreement, through friendly consultations, on the establishment of Friendship City Relationship.

1. The two sides will carry out, in accordance with the principles of mutual benefit, exchanges and cooperation between the two cities in various forms in the fields of economy, trade, science and technology, culture, education, sports, health, personnel, etc. to promote common prosperity and development.
2. Regular contacts shall be maintained between the leaders and relevant departments of the two sides to facilitate consultations on the exchanges and cooperation as well as matters of common concern.
3. This Agreement shall come into force from the date of signature. It will be valid for five years. Upon expiration, it may remain in force if neither side terminates it.
4. This Agreement, signed on June 1, 2010 in Door County, Wisconsin, is done in duplicate in the Chinese and English languages, both texts being equally authentic.
